A Mile in Our Boots is a three-day weekend training for clinicians who serve or want to serve the first responder community. The weekend will be full of interactive education – including wearing gear, hearing mayday tones, and more of the sensory aspects of public safety – that will allow our clinicians a realistic glimpse into the world of a first responder. Clinicians will be grouped into “squads” (teams) and will be participating in different activities that offer unique experiences through experiential learning. The clinician will be challenged while creating new memories and experiences that will be able to be utilized in their practice to best serve public servants.

Cost is \$100 to include full conference and all meals; partial registrations are not permitted. Lodging is not included and is the sole responsibility of the participant. Accommodation recommendations will be given at the time of registration.

Space is limited and registration will be on a first come basis. Interested clinicians will be placed on a waitlist if necessary.
